ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

ENTRY FEES

- Adults 18 and older - \$20.00
- Full-time Adult Students - \$15.00
- Students under 18 \$5.00
- Members of the TCAC benefit from a discounted entry fee. (\$5)
- Junior Members of TCAC discount entry (\$0)

ENTRIES

- Exhibitors may enter *one to three* works.
- Submitted work must be original and not copied.
- All work must be priced for sale, or marked NFS (not for sale).
- Each two dimensional work must have a tag attached to back, bottom left hand corner; sculptures must have required information attached out of sight.
- Each exhibitor must complete entry form and submit it at the same time work is entered on the receiving date, along with entrance fee. *This form must be signed as verification when your work is picked up at the close of the exhibit.*
- TCAC has the discretion to make exceptions to the entry requirements including size of work accepted.

SIZE OF WORK

- Two Dimensional:
4ft.x4ft., not to exceed 4ft. in either direction, including diptych/triptych.
- Sculptures:
Maximum overall dimensions (75lb. limit)
Table Display - 2ft.x1ft.x2ft. tall.
Free Standing - 2ft.x2ft.x4ft. tall.

SALE OF WORK

- All exhibited works marked for sale will be subject to a 30% commission.

AWARDS

- Award amounts stated may be monetary and/or cash value gift awards.

TYPES OF WORK

- Acrylics, oils, watercolors, mixed media, textiles, graphics (drawing, printmaking), sculpture. Commercially reproduced prints will not be received or accepted.

PICK UP

- All work whether accepted or unaccepted will be picked up on Sunday June 20 from 12-6pm, or on Monday June 21 from 5-7pm. NO EXCEPTIONS. No work will be picked up before the scheduled date and time.

AGREEMENT

- Entries will be handled with reasonable care; however, the Taylor County Arts Council, Inc. or persons involved with the coordination or aiding the exhibit will not be responsible for loss or damage from any cause whatsoever. No insurance is provided. *Your entry in this exhibit confirms this agreement. Permission to photograph or reproduce entries for newspapers or other publicity is hereby granted upon entry.*
- All work will be juried. Jurors decision is final.
